Co-decision making

- The Danish University Act (2003) – as the main challenge
- Organizational structure (Board with external majority)
- Decision-making
 - who is in charge: board – management?
- The board (and management) want confidentiality

Co-decision making

Two tracks:

- Collaboration board (department, faculty, and university level)
 - Information and involvement by EU and national laws
 - 4 recent cases of universities neglecting to inform and involve
- Councils (department and faculty level)
 - Endless herrings with short deadlines (not involvement)

Co-decision making

- Top management must report on co-decision-making
 - Examples of local solutions:
 - Copenhagen University: install new councils on the department level
 - Aalborg University: councils to be re-launched
- Counsels are counsels (main challenge unchanged)
